Sewer System Capacity

2020 Census for West Cornwall Township states average persons per household = 2.30 Flow per EDU per Act 57 = 2.30 persons x 65 gpd/capita = 150 gpd/household (EDU)

Capacity of the water system, as reported by the Quentin Water Company, is 115,000 gpd. Using 150 gpd/EDU, capacity = 767 EDUs.

Capacity Part Valuation

Attached work sheet, using the estimate replacement value method, shows Capacity Facilities value at \$2,100,000. Land value should be deleted from this total, therefore Capacity Facilities value for tapping fee purposes is \$1,700,000.

\$1,700,000 capacity value / 767 EDUs = \$2,216 capacity part



















Population by highest level of education










Veterans by wartime service
